The following are the questions presented to the *Shaykh* with the corresponding minute marker from the audio:

1. A brother found out that his mother changed his name at birth to other than the father’s family name. Is it upon the brother to legally change his name and that of his children to the father’s family name? [00:00:45]

The teachers of the weekend schools in the *masājid* want to keep the kids disciplined/organized so they put them between the men in the lines of the *ṣalāh* but some brothers say that the *Sunnah* is for them to be at the back, and sometimes there is an argument. *Yā Shaykh*, how are we to deal with this, bearing in mind that if we line up the kids alone behind the men they will cause problems?
