The following are the questions presented to the *Shaykh* with the corresponding minute marker from the audio:

1. How do you respond to those who say we need to be moderate and not go to extremes when you inform them of the commands and prohibitions in the *Dīn*? [00:04:18]
2. Some women believe that matters related to *manhaj* are only for the men. Is this correct? [00:18:32]
3. What advice do you have for the people who look down on those who refer to the scholars in all affairs? Even if some believe that the matter does not need the advice of a scholar. [00:20:13]
4. My question is about taking grants, free money given by the government to help law-income families pay for college, university, what is entailed is that you must apply for the assistance-plan. What you see is how much money you would receive for loans and for grants and send you a form to sign for both, but there is a separate form allowing you to decline the loan and only accept the grant which is money that is given and does not have to be repaid nor does it form interest. Is it permissible to accept this grant with the
