

## Weekly Question & Answer Session

with The Noble *Shaykh Ḥasan ibn ‘Abd Al-Wahhāb Marzūq al-Bannā* (حفظه الله)

Wednesday 14th *Sha‘bān*, 1437 | 21<sup>st</sup> May, 2016

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The following are the questions presented to the *Shaykh* with the corresponding minute marker from the audio:

1. Is it permissible to visit my non-Muslim neighbour who is sick? [00:01:30]
2. What are the conditions for getting married to a Christian woman if the man is [already] married to a Christian woman but then he accepted *Islām*, what should he do? [00:10:06]
3. A sister says that she is *Salafī* but she does not agree with the speech of the scholars regarding informing the authorities about those planning to join ISIS. She says that the Prophet (*sallAllāhu ‘alayhi wa sallam*) said that those who hand over his *Muslim* brother to non-Muslims are just like them (meaning he is also a disbeliever). However, she did not provide any proof for this statement. Would it be permissible for me to babysit the sister's children, as she sometimes asks me to do so? [00:20:31]
4. We have a brother at our *masjid* that used to be upon *Salafīyyah* and now some of the brothers have heard him say that we (meaning the *Salafīs*) are *Kuffār*. It took place that we caught him previously trying to cause *fitnah* and talking with the manners of the *Khawārij*. He went to the land of *Islām* and got affected by the likes of *Muḥammad Ḥasan*





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and other than him. And ever since he returned, he's been upon that page, he doesn't even make *ṣalāh* with us; he makes *ṣalāh* outside on the street around the *masjid*. [00:35:03]
