The following are the questions presented to the *Shaykh* with the corresponding minute marker from the audio:

1. A family travelled to Syria to join ISIS and left their wealth behind. Is it permissible for me to send them this money that is from their wealth? Also, if a brother purchases vehicles from them, can he send them the payments for these vehicles, knowing that they are now part of ISIS? [00:00:53]
2. Is it permissible for women, in particular older women, who have difficulty holding umbrellas, to wear hats or sun-risers in *Ihrām*? [00:09:13]
3. Is it permissible to get married over the phone with a sister who is in the presence of her *walī* and the witnesses and the man is in his country, however he has never met the sisters *walī* in person? [00:18:07]
4. If a brother joined ISIS believing they were upon the truth and died upon that, having love in his heart for **Allāh** and His Messenger and not having committed *shirk*, will he be resurrected as a *Muslim*? [00:24:09]
5. Is it permissible for a *Salafī* sister to sell ‘*abāyah*’s that are decorated to other sisters, if she knows they will wear them in public and not conceal the decorations on the ‘*abāyah*? [00:52:41]



6. Is it upon a woman who has a business-place to close it at the time of *Jumu'ah*? [01:02:33]
