The following are the questions presented to the Shaykh with the corresponding minute marker from the audio:

1. Is it preferable to marry a *Salafi*, or to listen to my father’s wishes, ordering to marry a person who is not a *Salafi*? [00:00:59]
2. When my husband proposed to me, he said that he would not take another wife, and this was one of the reasons my father and I agreed to the marriage. However, I did not write it as a condition at the time of the contract, if he gets married again, am I entitled to a *khula*’, as I feel he was deceptive in claiming that he had no intention of practicing polygyny? 3. Are machine slaughtered animals permissible for us to eat? [00:16:21]
4. When reciting from the *Qur’ān* in *ṣalāh*, do we have to maintain the order of the *Sūrah*, for example: in the first *raka’ah* we recite *Sūrah al-Falaq* and then *Sūrah an-Nās* in the second. Or can we recite *Sūrah an-Nās* in the first and *Sūrah al-Falaq* in the second? [00:22:11]
5. Is it permissible to stand up and urinate in a public bathroom, because it’s very dirty in the stall? [00:29:37]
